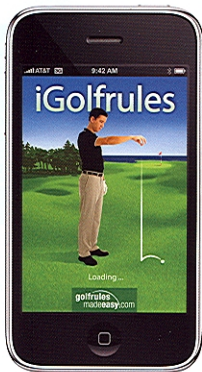
GOLF RULES QUICK REFERENCE IPHONE APP —

WHEN FACED WITH A QUESTION regarding rules, golfers would typically consult a booklet nearly 200 pages long. Not anymore.

Written by Yves C. Ton-That, an international rules official for more than ten years, there is now an iPhone/iPod application that allows a player to simply touch the screen in an area that corresponds to the circumstances surrounding his or her ball to — within seconds — find the answer or procedure on how to correctly address the situation.

Called by *Golf Digest* "...the best effort yet to decipher the Rules of Golf", the app features more than 200 illustrations and animated slide shows that display real-time 3D graphics with great clarity.

Awarded "Best New Product" at the golf industry's two largest golf trade shows, the "iGolfrules" application is available from the iTunes App Store. HOUSE OF CARRINGTON OUTERWEAR —

TIMELESS, CLASSIC GOLF APPAREL has a decidedly British personality thanks to Andy and Tim Bell, entrepreneurs who launched the high-end clothing company in 2005.

Working from a "back story" centered around characters residing in the House of Carrington, an estate overlooking the English Channel, the two brothers stitched together a collection of fine tailored clothing and sportswear defined by evident detailing and luxurious fabrics.

The brands — worn comfortably on the course, the tennis court or in the office — features names such as The Legend, Oxford Knights and Westminster Palace.

Especially appealing to the younger golfer, the Blacksheep brand exudes the sophistication of Saville Row, yet infuses the rebelliousness of rock 'n' roll. Isabelle, a brand tailored to women, has a relaxed sophistication and subdued sexiness.

MIURA "SERIES 1957" PUTTERS —

ACCORDING TO PELZ GOLF INSTITUTE RESEARCH, golfers lose almost 80 percent of their shots to par inside of 100 yards from the green — with poor putting being one of the leading shot stealers.

With his Series 1957 putters, Katsuhiro Miura may have designed just what golfers need to lower their scores. Often referred to in the Japanese media as having the Hands of God, the master craftsman actually works in his factory every day with his two sons.

The toe weighted, off set blade putter — named so in honor of the year Miura got his start in the golf business — features an extremely forging milled face that produces a strike that helps achieve the truest of rolls through reduced skidding.

Forged in two weights — 350 and 370 grams — the putters give golfers improved feel and distance control, while an oiled nickel/chrome finish exudes a classic appearance.

Three models — the KM-350, MP-005 and MP-006 — have three shaft options and the slightly larger heads on the double 0 series may give golfers a bit more confidence around the green. Suggested retail price: \$390. www.miuragolf.com.
